

**BUSH LEAGUE BY-LAWS**

**SECTION I, OBJECT**

FOUNDED IN 1958, THE BUSH LEAGUE, A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION, PROVIDES IT'S MEMBERS WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO MEET OTHER GOLFERS OF THE CLEARWATER COUNTRY CLUB. THE LEAGUE IS OPERATED SOLELY FOR THE ENJOYMENT OF ITS MEMBERS.

**SECTION II. AUTHORIZATION**

THE BUSH LEAGUE IS AN AUTHORIZED 18 HOLE LEAGUE SANCTIONED BY THE CLEARWATER COUNTRY CLUB BOARD OF GOVERNORS. THE LEAGUE HAS BEEN ALLOCATED (15) FIFTEEN STARTING TIMES ON EACH MONDAY, WEDNESDAY AND FRIDAY OF THE YEAR.

**SECTION III. BOARD OF GOVERNORS**

- A. THE AFFAIRS OF THE BUSH LEAGUE ARE MANAGED BY A BOARD OF GOVERNORS CONSISTING OF FIVE (5) OFFICERS: PRESIDENT, VICE PRESIDENT/SECRETARY, TREASURER, MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN AND ENTERTAINMENT CHAIRMAN.
- B. THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS IS THREE YEARS. UPON EXPIRATION OF THEIR TWO (3) YEAR TERMS, MEMBERS OF THE BOARD LEAVE OFFICE EACH YEAR ON THE DATE OF THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE LEAGUE MEMBERS, UNLESS THEY ARE RE-NOMINATED AND RE-ELECTED FOR A SECOND TERM. IF NOT ELIGIBLE FOR RE-ELECTION OR IF NOT RE-NOMINATED AND RE-ELECTED, THEY ARE REPLACED BY NEW OFFICERS SELECTED BY THE LEAGUE MEMBERS AT THE ANNUAL MEETING. THE NUMBER ELECTED WILL VARY WITH THE NUMBER OF VACANCIES TO BE FILLED.
- C. AT THE ANNUAL MEETING AND FOLLOWING THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS, AN ELECTION WILL BE HELD FOR THE OFFICE OF BUSH LEAGUE PRESIDENT. ONLY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE CANDIDATES. THE GOVERNOR RECEIVING THE MOST VOTES OF THE MEMBERS PRESENT SHALL BE DECLARED ELECTED. THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT IS FOR ONE YEAR, UNLESS HE IS RE-ELECTED FOR A SECOND OR THIRD TERM. NO BOARD MEMBER MAY SUCCEED HIMSELF AS PRESIDENT FOR MORE THAN TWO(2) TERMS
- D. NO BOARD MEMBER MAY SUCCEED HIMSELF AFTER SERVING TWO CONSECUTIVE THREE YEAR TERMS HOWEVER AFTER A LAPSE OF TWO YEARS HE IS AGAIN ELIGIBLE FOR ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT. A BOARD MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE BOARD PRESIDENT MAY BE ELECTED TWO TIMES BY THE MEMBERS.
- E. WITHIN ONE WEEK AFTER THE ELECTION OF NEW BOARD MEMBERS AND THE PRESIDENT, THE PRESIDENT WILL CALL A MEETING OF THE BOARD TO DETERMINE FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE INDIVIDUAL BOARD MEMBERS
- F. IF FOR ANY REASON A BOARD MEMBER IS UNABLE TO COMPLETE HIS TERM OF OFFICE, THE PRESIDENT, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MAJORITY OF THE BOARD, MAY APPOINT A MEMBER OF THE LEAGUE TO FILL THE VACANCY FOR THE UNCOMPLETED TERM.

**SECTION IV. OFFICERS**

**A. PRESIDENT.**

THE PRESIDENT SHALL BE THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE LEAGUE. HE SHALL CALL, AND PRESIDE AT ALL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD AND/OR THE LEAGUE MEMBERS. HE SHALL ENFORCE ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LEAGUE.

**B. VICE-PRESIDENT-SECRETARY**

IN THE ABSENCE OF THE PRESIDENT, THE VICE PRESIDENT SHALL PERFORM ALL OF HIS DUTIES. HE SHALL PERFORM ANY OTHER SUCH DUTIES AS MAY BE ASSIGNED TO HIM BY THE PRESIDENT FROM TIME TO TIME. AS SECRETARY, HE SHALL CONDUCT ALL OFFICIAL CORRESPONDENCE OF THE LEAGUE, KEEP NEAT AND ACCURATE MINUTES OF ALL MEETINGS AND POST OR DISTRIBUTE ANY INFORMATIVE LEAGUE

INFORMATION TO THE MEMBERS. HE SHALL MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE ROSTER OF THE MEMBERSHIP PROVIDED FOR HIM BY THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN.

THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH THE MONTHLY WORKING COMMITTEES. THESE COMMITTEES SHALL CONSIST OF AT LEAST **FOUR (4)** MEMBERS. HE SHALL DESIGNATE TWO (2) MEMBERS OF EACH COMMITTEE TO SERVE AS COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN AND CO-CHAIRMAN. THE LIST OF MONTHLY WORKING COMMITTEES WILL BE POSTED ON THE BULLETIN BOARD.

**C. TREASURER**

THE TREASURER SHALL BE THE CUSTODIAN OF ALL LEAGUE FUNDS. HE SHALL RECEIVE ALL MEMBERSHIP AND DUES FEES FROM THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN OR THE MONTHLY WORKING COMMITTEE. HE SHALL RECEIVE , AT THE END OF EACH MONTH, THE AMOUNT COLLECTED FOR THE TREASURY FROM THE DAILY ENTRY FEES AS COLLECTED BY THE WORKING COMMITTEE, AS SHOWN IN SECTION VIII, PARA "E". HE SHALL DEPOSIT ALL LEAGUE FUNDS INTO A CHECKING ACCOUNT AT A LOCAL BANK. THE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE FUNDS AS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD. CHECKS FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS SHALL BE SIGNED BY EITHER THE PRESIDENT OR TREASURER. HE SHALL KEEP NEAT AND ACCURATE RECORDS OF INCOME AND DISBURSEMENTS. HE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE LEAGUE MEMBERS COMPLETE INFORMATION AS TO THE FINANCIAL CONDITION OF THE LEAGUE AT THE ANNUAL MEETING.

**D. MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN**

1. THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE BUSH LEAGUE SHALL NOT EXCEED 90 GOLF MEMBERS.
2. THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN SHALL MAINTAIN AN UP-TO-DATE ROSTER OF MEMBERS. COPIES SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING.
3. HE SHALL MAINTAIN A LIST OF APPLICANTS WHO HAVE REQUESTED MEMBERSHIP IN THE BUSH LEAGUE. THE APPLICATION WILL INCLUDE APPLICANT'S NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER, SPONSOR'S NAME AND DATE OF APPLICATION.
4. ALL APPLICANTS MUST BE SPONSORED BY A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING OF THE BUSH LEAGUE.
5. THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN SHALL SUBMIT NAMES OF APPLICANTS TO THE BOARD FOR APPROVAL BEFORE PLACING THEIR NAMES ON THE WAITING LIST.
6. MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN WILL RETAIN A LIST OF ALL APPLICANTS IN CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER AND SELECT QUALIFIERS IN THAT ORDER. NAMES OF QUALIFIERS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD FOR THEIR APPROVAL.
7. THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A ROSTER OF ASSOCIATE MEMBERS INCLUDING NAMES AND ADDRESSES. HE SHALL MAIL TO EACH ASSOCIATE MEMBER THE ANNUAL ACTIVITIES SCHEDULE.

**E. ENTERTAINMENT CHAIRMAN**

THE ENTERTAINMENT CHAIRMAN SHALL PLAN, PUBLICIZE AND SUPERVISE ANY AND ALL EVENTS OF AN ENTERTAINMENT AND/OR SOCIAL NATURE. HE SHALL ADHERE TO BUDGETARY ALLOWANCES AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD.

**SECTION V. ANNUAL MEETING**

- A. AN ANNUAL MEETING OF ALL LEAGUE MEMBERS SHALL BE HELD ON OR ABOUT THE 15TH DAY OF MARCH OF EACH YEAR FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING NEW OFFICERS AND CONDUCTING ANY OTHER BUSINESS WHICH MAY COME BEFORE THE MEETING. A QUORUM FOR THE ANNUAL MEETING WILL BE FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE MEMBERSHIP.
- B. A SPECIAL MEETING MAY BE CALLED BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD OR UPON A PETITION SIGNED BY A MINIMUM OF TWENTY (20) MEMBERS AND SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD. A SPECIAL

- C. MEETING WILL BE HELD WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF SUBMISSION. FULL DISCLOSURE OF THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WILL BE SUBMITTED.

**SECTION VI. MEMBERSHIP**

**A. NEW MEMBERS:**

1. ANY NEW MALE MEMBER OF THE CLUB IS ELIGIBLE TO JOIN IF HE CAN MEET THE CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN AND IF AN OPENING IN THE LEAGUE IS AVAILABLE. AN APPLICANT MUST QUALIFY BY PLAYING THREE (3) 18 HOLE ROUNDS AND SCORING A MINIMUM OF THIRTY (30) QUOTA POINTS. POINTS ARE SCORED AS EXPLAINED IN SECTION X, PARA "J". THE BOARD HAS THE AUTHORITY TO ADJUST REQUIRED QUOTA POINTS.
2. MEMBERS OF CCC WITH AN ESTABLISHED HANDICAP DO NOT NEED TO QUALIFY. **ALL APPLICANTS** MUST BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD.

- B. MEMBERS CAN BE DISCIPLINED OR EXPELLED FOR CAUSE BY THE UNANIMOUS VOTE OF THE BOARD.**

**C. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP:**

1. THERE SHALL BE AN ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP CATEGORY. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS SHALL BE FORMER BUSH LEAGUE MEMBERS WHO FOR PHYSICAL OR OTHER REASONS NO LONGER WISH TO BE A PLAYING MEMBER OF THE LEAGUE
2. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS SHALL NOT PAY DUES AND HAVE NO VOTING PRIVILEGES. THEY MAY ATTEND ALL SOCIAL FUNCTIONS UPON FULL PAYMENT FOR THE FUNCTION.
3. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS WISHING TO RETURN TO ACTIVE GOLFING MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE GIVEN PREFERENCE AND SHALL RE-ESTABLISH THEIR POINT QUOTA.
4. UPON TERMINATING HIS GOLF MEMBERSHIP, THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN WILL ADVISE THE DEPARTING MEMBER OF THE AVAILABILITY OF THE ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP.

**SECTION VII. INITIATION FEES AND DUES**

INITIATION FEE IS \$25.00. ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP DUES ARE \$24.00 PAYABLE DURING THE MONTH OF JANUARY OF EACH YEAR. IMMEDIATELY AFTER QUALIFYING AND ACCEPTANCE INTO THE LEAGUE A NEW MEMBER SHALL PAY THE \$25.00 INITIATION FEE AND HIS DUES, THE LATTER PRO-RATED AT \$2.00 PER MONTH.

**SECTION VIII. MONTHLY WORKING COMMITTEE**

THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SCHEDULING OF AT LEAST TWO (2) MEMBERS TO SERVE ON ANY DAY OF PLAY.

THE WORKING COMMITTEE PERFORMS THE FOLLOWING FUNCTIONS:

- A. ESTABLISHES TEAMS BY COMPUTER (RANDOM SELECTION), WITH THE FLEXIBILITY TO ALLOW FOR PERSONAL CIRCUMSTANCES.
- B. COMPUTES AND DISTRIBUTES PRIZE MONEY ON THE BASIS OF AN ESTABLISHED SCHEDULE APPROVED BY THE BOARD AND CONFORMING TO THE PROVISION OF SECTION X, PARA "E", A COPY OF WHICH IS PROVIDED FOR THE USE OF THE COMMITTEE AND ADJUSTED AS NECESSARY. THE PAYOUT SYSTEM IS DESIGNED TO KEEP WINNING MONIES RELATIVELY CLOSE TOGETHER. THIS CAN CAUSE SOME ABNORMALITIES TO OCCUR WHEN TEAMS HAPPEN TO HAVE THREE MEMBERS. THEREFORE, THE COMMITTEES ARE INSTRUCTED TO MODIFY THE PAYOUTS TO ASSURE THAT 2<sup>ND</sup>, 3<sup>RD</sup>, AND 4<sup>TH</sup> PLACE TEAMS WIN LESS MONIES THAN 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup>, AND 3<sup>RD</sup> PLACE TEAMS. IN ADDITION, IF A 3 MAN TEAM TIES WITH A 4 MAN TEAM EACH MAN ON BOTH TEAMS WILL RECEIVE THE SAME WINNINGS.

- C. .DECIDES, AFTER A 20 MINUTE WAITING PERIOD, TO PLAY OR CALL OFF PLAY IN THE CASE OF QUESTIONABLE WEATHER AT THE STARTING TIME OR AFTER PLAY HAS STARTED. IF PLAY HAS BEEN CALLED OFF AND IF ALL TEAMS HAVE COMPLETED NINE (9) HOLES, PAYMENT WILL BE MADE ON THE BASIS OF NINE (9) HOLE SCORES. IF PLAY HAS BEEN CALLED OFF BEFORE NINE (9) HOLES HAVE BEEN COMPLETED BY ALL TEAMS, NO FEES WILL BE COLLECTED. IF, AFTER PLAY IS BEGUN, THE COMMITTEE CALLS OFF PLAY, IT IS THE DUTY OF THE COMMITTEE TO NOTIFY PLAYERS OUT ON THE COURSE OF THE DECISION TO CALL OFF PLAY.
- D. COMPUTER RECORDS WILL SHOW ALL LEAGUE PLAYERS' QUOTAS.
- E. AT OR BEFORE THE END OF THE MONTH TURN OVER TO THE TREASURER FUNDS COLLECTED DURING THE MONTH.

## **SECTION IX. TEAM CAPTAIN**

- A. ON EACH TEAM, THE PLAYER WITH THE HIGHEST POINT QUOTA SHALL SERVE AS CAPTAIN. IF TWO (2) OR MORE PLAYERS ON A TEAM HAVE QUOTAS EQUALLY HIGH, THE ONE WHOSE NAME APPEARS FIRST ON THE SCORE CARD WILL BE THE CAPTAIN.
- B. THE TEAM CAPTAIN IS RESPONSIBLE FOR:
  - 1. THE ACCURACY, VERIFICATION AND RECORDING OF TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL SCORING. THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TEAM CAPTAIN SHOULD NOT BE DELEGATED.
  - 2. COLLECTION OF ALL FEES AT OR BEFORE COMPLETION OF THE DAYS PLAY.
  - 3. TURNING IN THE COLLECTED FEE AND A LEGIBLE, ACCURATE SCORE CARD TO THE MONTHLY WORKING COMMITTEE IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF PLAY.
  - 4. NOTIFY THE MONTHLY WORKING COMMITTEE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE IF FOR ANY REASON HIS TEAM HAS FAILED TO COMPLETE 18 HOLES.
  - 5. THE TEAM IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF GOLF RULES AND REGULATIONS. THEY WILL DISCUSS ANY REPORTED OR OBSERVED VIOLATIONS WITH THE PLAYER INVOLVED AND IF NECESSARY ADVISE THE MONTHLY COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

## **SECTION X. PROCEDURES FOR DAILY PLAY:**

- A. PLAY IN THE BUSH LEAGUE IS LIMITED TO SIXTY (60) PLAYERS PER DAY.
- B. ON ANY BUSH LEAGUE PLAY DAY, A MEMBER MAY INDICATE HIS DESIRE TO PLAY ON THE NEXT SCHEDULED DAY OF PLAY BY CHECKING OF HIS NAME ON THE STARTING ROSTER IN THE PRO SHOP OR BY PHONING THE PRO SHOP DESK AND ASKING THE ATTENDANT TO CHECK OFF HIS NAME.
- C. THE TEAM LIST FOR EACH DAY OF PLAY WILL BE MADE UP IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE: AS SOON AS FEASIBLE AFTER NOON ON EACH LEAGUE PLAY DAY, THE WORKING COMMITTEE WILL BEGIN PREPARING THE TEAM LIST FOR THE NEXT DAY OF LEAGUE PLAY. ASIDE FROM ADJUSTMENTS MADE FOR SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES, THE MAKE UP OF THE TEAMS WILL BE DECIDED BY RANDOM SELECTION BY COMPUTER EXCEPT AS NOTED IN SECTION VIII(A). UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD A PLAYER BE MOVED FROM ONE TEAM TO ANOTHER FOR PERSONAL CONVENIENCE. ANY PROPOSED CHANGES AFTER TEAM LISTS HAVE BEEN POSTED WILL BE MADE ONLY BY THE COMMITTEE.
- D. ANY ENTRANT SIGNING AFTER THE TEAM LIST HAS BEEN POSTED WILL BE PLACED ON STANDBY IN NUMERICAL ORDER AND WILL BE ADDED TO THE LIST IN THE SAME ORDER AS OPENINGS OCCUR. STANDBYS WILL BE PLACED ON TEAMS AS DETERMINED BY THE COMMITTEE.
- E. THE ENTRY FEE FOR EACH DAY OF PLAY IS \$3.00 FROM WHICH ABOUT 10% IS DEPOSITED IN THE LEAGUE TREASURY TO BE USED FOR SOCIAL EVENTS AND OTHER LEAGUE EXPENSES. OF THE REMAINDER, 80% IS PAID OUT EACH DAY TO THE WINNING TEAMS, AND 20% TO THE WINNING INDIVIDUALS.

- F. IF A PLAYER, FOR REASONS OF HEALTH OR SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES DESIRES TO PLAY LESS THAN 18 HOLES, HE MUST NOTIFY THE WORKING COMMITTEE PRIOR TO THEIR POSTING THE SCHEDULE OF TEAMS FOR THE DAYS PLAY. HE SHALL BE PLACED AT THE END OF THAT DAY'S PLAY IN A NINE HOLE GROUP. HE SHALL NOT PAY AN ENTRY FEE.
- G. ONCE A PLAYER BEGINS A ROUND, HE IS COMMITTED TO PAY THE ENTRY FEE OF \$3.00, REGARDLESS OF HOW MANY HOLES HE PLAYS. IF A PLAYER DECIDES TO DROP OUT FOR ANY REASON, HE FORFEITS HIS ENTRY FEE, AND HIS TEAM CONTINUES ON AS A THREESOME.
- H. IF A THREESOME IS IN PLAY, AND A MEMBER DROPS OUT, SUCH MEMBER SHALL FORFEIT HIS ENTRY FEE. THE REMAINING TWO MEMBERS WILL CONTINUE PLAYING FOR INDIVIDUAL WINNINGS, BUT NOT FOR TEAM WINNINGS. THE SCORES OF THE FINISHING MEMBERS WILL BE RECORDED.
- I. ANY PLAYER NOT PRESENT WHEN HIS STARTING TIME IS CALLED, AND HAS FAILED TO CANCEL, IS COMMITTED TO PAY THE \$3.00 ENTRY FEE TO BE PUT IN THE PRIZE MONEY. IF HE ARRIVES LATE, HE WILL BE PLACED IN THE FIRST AVAILABLE OPENING BY THE WORKING COMMITTEE.
- J. SCORING IS BY THE POINT SYSTEM: 4 POINTS FOR AN EAGLE, 3 POINTS FOR A BIRDIE, 2 POINTS FOR A PAR, AND 1 POINT FOR A BOGIE. EACH PLAYER HAS A SET QUOTA OF POINTS TO SCORE, DETERMINED BY AN AVERAGE OF HIS LAST 10 SCORES. HIS FINAL SCORE IS DETERMINED BY THE NUMBER OF POINTS SCORED OVER OR UNDER HIS QUOTA. INDIVIDUAL SCORES ARE COMBINED FOR THE TEAM SCORE.
- K. ANY APPLICANT ATTEMPTING TO QUALIFY FOR MEMBERSHIP SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PLAY A QUALIFYING ROUND WHEN AND IF SUCH PLAY WOULD DEPRIVE A REGULAR MEMBER FROM PLAYING.
- L. LEAGUE MEMBERS MAY HAVE GUESTS, HOWEVER A MEMBER MAY HAVE ONE GUEST NO MORE THAN THREE(3) TIMES IN ONE MONTH.
- M. GUESTS OF LEAGUE MEMBERS ARE PERMITTED TO PLAY ONLY WHEN SUCH PLAY DOES NOT DEPRIVE A REGULAR MEMBER FROM ENTERING THE DAY'S PLAY OR DURING A TOURNAMENT. IN GENERAL MEMBERS WITH GUESTS SHOULD BE PLACED AT THE END OF THE PLAY SHEET.

**SECTION XI. RULES OF PLAY.**

- A. THE BUSH LEAGUE WILL PLAY BY THE STANDARD U.S.G.A. RULES AS MODIFIED BY ANY LOCAL CCC MODIFICATION TO THESE RULES.
- B. MEMBERS WHO ARE 80 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER ARE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY FROM THE GOLD TEES.
- C. EVERY EFFORT SHALL BE MADE TO SPEED UP PLAY.
- D. ALL PLAY SHALL BE FROM THE WHITE TEES WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS.  
  
MEMBERS WHO HAVE DIFFICULTY PLAYING FROM THE WHITE TEES AND HAVE A QUOTA LESS THAN TEN (10) MAY REQUEST PERMISSION FROM THE BOARD TO PLAY FROM THE GOLD TEES. IF APPROVED HIS QUOTA WILL BE ADJUSTED BY ADDING TWO POINTS TO EACH OF THE LAST 10 SCORES AND USING THE NEW TOTAL FOR SUBSEQUENT QUOTA CALCULATIONS. THE REVERSE CALCULATIONS WILL APPLY IF APPROVAL IS GRANTED FOR RETURN TO THE WHITE TEES. THESE CALCULATIONS ARE ACCOMPLISHED BY CHANGING THE TEES PLAYED FROM IN THE COMPUTER.

**SECTION XII. HOLE-IN-ONE-CLUB**

MEMBERSHIP IN THE BUSH LEAGUE "HOLE-IN-ONE-CLUB" IS VOLUNTARY. ALL BUSH LEAGUERS ARE INVITED TO JOIN. IN JANUARY OF EACH YEAR, MEMBERS OF THE "HOLE-IN-ONE-CLUB" MUST MAKE A COMMITMENT TO PAY ONE DOLLAR FOR EVERY ACE SCORED IN THAT YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE "HOLE-IN-ONE-CLUB" IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ESTABLISHED RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH HAVE BEEN PUBLISHED SEPARATELY. THE TREASURER WILL COLLECT \$1.00 FROM ALL MEMBERS OF THE "HOLE-IN-ONE" CLUB EACH TIME A "HOLE-IN-ONE-CLUB" MEMBER SCORES A HOLE IN ONE.

**SECTION XIII. SOCIAL FUNCTIONS**

- A. ANY MEMBER MAY BRING ONE MALE GUEST TO ANY STAG DINNER EXCEPT THE ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING UPON PAYING THE FULL PRICE OF THE MEAL FOR HIS GUEST.
- B. NO MEMBER MAY BRING MORE THAN ONE FEMALE GUEST TO ANY LADIES' NIGHT FUNCTION WITHOUT OBTAINING PRIOR APPROVAL FROM THE LEAGUE PRESIDENT. THE MEMBER SHALL PAY THE FULL PRICE OF THE MEAL FOR ANY SUCH ADDITIONAL GUEST.
- C. MEMBERS OF THE LEAGUE WHO, FOR PHYSICAL OR OTHER VALID REASON, CAN NO LONGER REGULARLY PLAY GOLF MAY BE DECLARED ASSOCIATE MEMBERS BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS. SUCH MEMBERS PAY NO DUES AND HAVE NO VOTING PRIVILEGES. THEY MAY, HOWEVER, ATTEND ALL SOCIAL FUNCTIONS UPON PAYMENT OF THE FULL PRICE OF THE MEAL. ANY ASSOCIATE MEMBER SEEKING TO RE-QUALIFY FOR ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP WILL BE GIVEN PREFERENCE BY THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN.
