Rules Quiz

The June 2016 Rules Quiz referred you to the definition of "address the ball" in the Rules of Golf for the answer. But if you were to look for that definition now, it has been removed. Why?

Rules Quiz Answer

In the updated 2019 Rules of Golf, if a ball at rest on the putting green is accidentally moved by the golfer, there is no penalty so long as the ball is replaced. Situations other than on the putting green are covered by Rule 9 – Ball Played as it Lies; Ball at Rest Lifted or Moved. In that rule and in other places in the rule book, the "beginning of one's stroke" or "prior to the beginning of one's stroke" are the starting points rather than "before" or "after" addressing the ball. So the definition of "address the ball" became superfluous and was removed.
