## Rules Quiz Answer:

If Paul had returned a card with the score for any hole lower than the actual, yes he would be disqualified. If he returned a card with any hole score that was higher than actual, the higher score would stand. However, under Rule 3.3b(5), a player is not responsible for incorrect addition on the scorecard, so Paul is not disqualified.
