The “**Shooter's World Invitational Pro-Pro-Am-Am**” took place on Thursday, February 9. The full field of 25 teams enjoyed sunny and breezy weather as the action started at noon. Each team consisted of two pros and two amateurs. The foursome score was the best net ball + best gross ball on each hole. The pros also competed in a pro-pro competition, where their team score was the gross best ball of the twosome on each hole. Three teams tied for first with 131's in the foursome competition: **Kenny Knox, Sean Butschee, JD Goins & Marcus Beck and Andy Pope, Brian Richey, John Blazon & Scott Musumeci and Kevin Roy, Matt Campbell, DJ Guggi & Kyle Roy**. In the pro-pro competition **Andy Pope / Brian Richey** led the way with a 63, followed by a pair of 64's from **Travis / John Huston and Bryan Moran / Brad Bryant**. That was followed by no less than five teams tied at 65. Former PGA Tour players in the field included **Brad Bryant, John Daly, Chris Dimarco, John Huston and Kenny Knox**.

The final regular season event on the **Pinellas County Men's Golf Association** was held on Tuesday, February 28. The home team prevailed with a score of 277 here at CCC. One stroke back at 278 was Dunedin Golf Club. In third place was Pasadena with a 282. Low Pro was Pasadena's **Fielding Brewbaker** with a 73, followed by our own **Gregory McClimans** and **Davis Harrison** (Belleair) with a pair of 75's. The final three events are the “playoffs”. Season points are reset to 0 and the five clubs with the highest season point totals are in the “Championship” bracket and will vie for the Season Championship based on their cumulative total of points in the three events. The other five clubs will compete in the “Interclub” bracket. The Championship Bracket is Pasadena (46 pts), Vinoy (43.5), Dunedin (41.5), Countryside (36.5) and East Lake (32.5). The Interclub Bracket is CCC (29.5), Seminole (27.5), Cypress Run (25.5), Belleair (23.5) and Innisbrook (22). The playoff events will also be the same as the monthly events, but will feature enhanced prizes for the Playoff Point totals over the three events.

On February 23 **Nancy and Randy Guilds** were playing with **Carole and Max Millsbaugh**. On the par 3 #16, Nancy pulled a 5-wood out of her bag, teed one up and hit it into the cup for an ace.
