Congratulations

The final playoff event of the 2023/2024 Pinellas County Men's Interclub Golf Association (PCMIGA) season took place on Monday, May 6 at Vinoy. Going into this final event, in the Championship Bracket, Cypress Run was in first place with 8 playoff points, followed by Ardea with 7 ½ points and Clearwater with 7 points. With a strong showing and a little slip by Cypress Run & Ardea, Clearwater could have won it's first season championship! But it wasn't in the cards as Ardea won and picked up 5 points, Clearwater & Cypress Run tied for 2nd and picked up 2.5 points each. So Ardea finished 1st with 12.5 total points, Cypress run dropped to 2nd with 10.5 points and CCC finished 3rd with 9.5 total points. Maybe next year?

There was a 5-way tie for 3rd place in the 2-Man competition, which included the powerful duo of **Scott Weathersby** and **Larry Olesky**, but that logjam was broken by a match of cards won by the Hernandez/Lenhart pair from The Vinoy. The match of cards for the 2-man competition starts by comparing the 10-18 totals, then if the tie continues the 13-18 totals, then 16-18, then finally by the handicap holes, toughest first.

The PCMIGA has been going since 1978 and although Clearwater has won many of the monthly events, it has never won the Season Championship. The 2024/2025 season starts up in September.
